

Famille Perrin 'Signature',
Organic Côtes-du-Rhône 2023
 Côtes-du-Rhône, Southern Rhône, France



PRODUCER

The Perrin family started farming organically in 1950 at Château de Beaucastel with the strong belief that it helps to express the sense of place in the finished wine. It is therefore of little surprise that their philosophy has led to the creation of an organic range of wines sourced from the family's certified vineyards across the Côtes-du-Rhône region.

VINEYARDS

The Côtes-du-Rhône Rouge Nature is a blend of Grenache and Syrah, sourced from organically certified vineyards which are located between Valréas and Vaison-la-Romaine, north of Orange. The vineyards are planted on chalk and clay soils that lend depth and purity of fruit to the wine.

VINTAGE

Following a particularly dry winter, the 2023 spring was characterized by stormy episodes and localized hailstorms. Drought and late summer heatwave did not have an impact on the vineyards, which benefited from a large diurnal range, allowing the vines to recover during the cool nights. In the Southern Rhone, 2023 was a long-lasting vintage that favoured the perfect phenolic ripeness. Wines show balance along with lovely acidity levels and freshness.

VINIFICATION

Upon arrival at the winery, the grapes were carefully sorted and de-stemmed. Fermentation took place in stainless-steel tanks at controlled temperatures, with regular pump overs to extract both colour and flavour. After fermentation the wine was aged in both used oak barrels and stainless-steel vats before blending and bottling.

TASTING NOTES

This wine is a deep ruby in colour. The expressive nose displays aromas of violets, dark fruit and strawberries, with hints of black pepper and thyme. The palate is juicy and approachable, with supple tannins that linger on the finish.
