PRODUCER

Flora Springs, based in St. Helena, was founded in 1978 by the Komes Garvey family and named in honour of Flora Komes, whose belief that "the land returns the love you give it" and helped establish the estate's long-standing focus on sustainable viticulture. Acquired in 2024 by Gina Gallo-Boisset and Jean-Charles Boisset, the estate continues its family-led legacy with a renewed emphasis on sustainability and Napa Valley expression. Napa native, Gina, brings more than 30 years of winemaking experience to the estate, crafting wines from some of the region's most prestigious AVAs, including Rutherford, St. Helena and Oakville. Long-term grower partnerships support sourcing from organically farmed vineyards with a strong focus on soil health, water conservation and biodiversity initiatives such as owl boxes and raptor perches.

VINEYARDS

The 'Trilogy' is a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot grown in the 'Komes Ranch' vineyard in Rutherford. Perched at up to 300 metres elevation in the Mayacamas, the vineyard is bordered by oak and redwood forests and benefits from a cooler microclimate, resulting in wines defined by a remarkable freshness and precise aromatics. Soils are composed of gravel and loam and the vineyard is farmed following organic practices with a particular focus on soil health and biodiversity.

VINTAGE

The 2023 vintage in the Napa Valley was one of the longest and most balanced growing seasons in over a decade. Consistently mild weather throughout the year, excellent water reserves from winter rains, and extended hang time led to above-average yields and exceptional fruit quality. A cool summer with steady sunshine allowed for slow, even ripening, ideal for developing deep colour and flavour complexity in the red wines. The resulting wines show remarkable purity, freshness, and structure, with ripe phenolics contributing to a refined tannic backbone and excellent ageing potential.

VINIFICATION

The hand-harvested Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot grapes were destemmed and crushed upon arrival at the winery and underwent a pre-fermentation maceration on the skins for three days to extract colour, tannin and flavour. Following fermentation in stainless steel with daily punch downs, the wine was aged in a combination of French and American oak, 35% of which was new, before the final blend was assembled and bottled.

TASTING NOTES

A complex and elegant Napa Valley red. Aromas of black cherry, blackberry and violet leap out of the glass and are married with subtle spicy notes of cedar and cocoa. Broad and generous on the palate, with polished tannins and a refreshing acidity which drives the complex flavours onto the long finish.
